Since 1999, the Dane County Urban County Consortium has funded housing and community development programs to support low-to-moderate income (LMI) households living in Dane County consortium communities outside the City of Madison. Approximately \$1.1 million in CDBG and \$600,000 in HOME funding is distributed annually.

Job creation activities with business development & trainings
