All funding is contingent upon Federal action on these programs.

The CDBG Commission recommends the following contingencies, in the event there is an increase or decrease in the federal CDBG and HOME grant awards to Dane County:

- In the event of an increase of CDBG funds, the following applies in order:
  - Project Home Major Home Rehabilitation would receive up to their minimum, combined with any increase in HOME funds;
  - Access Community Health Center (ACHC) would receive funding up to their minimum request;
  - Madison Black Chamber of Commerce, would receive funding up to their minimum request:
  - If ACHC cannot accept less than the minimum funds, those funds would then support Madison Black Chamber of Commerce.
- In the event of an increase in HOME funds, the following applies:
  - Project Home Major Home Rehabilitation would receive up to their minimum, combined with any increase in CDBG funds;
- If agencies cannot accept less than their minimum request, then those funds would follow the increase in funding contingency above.
- In the event of an increase in Public Services funds, then support Focused Interruption at their minimum, Legal Action of Wisconsin, and Affordable Dental Care, in that order.
- In the event of a decrease in CDBG, CDBG Public Services, or HOME funds, each agency awarded funds would be reduced by the same percentage.

Dane County is an Entitlement community under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) programs. The County receives approximately \$1.1 million in CDBG funding

and \$500,000 in HOME funding. In order to allocate CDBG and HOME funds, HUD requires the development of a Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan that govern how Dane County and the 59 participating municipalities expend the federal funds and the submittal of a One Year Action Plan.

CDBG funds are intended to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and by expanding economic opportunities, principally for low-and-moderate income persons. HOME funds are to be used exclusively to create affordable housing for low-income households.
